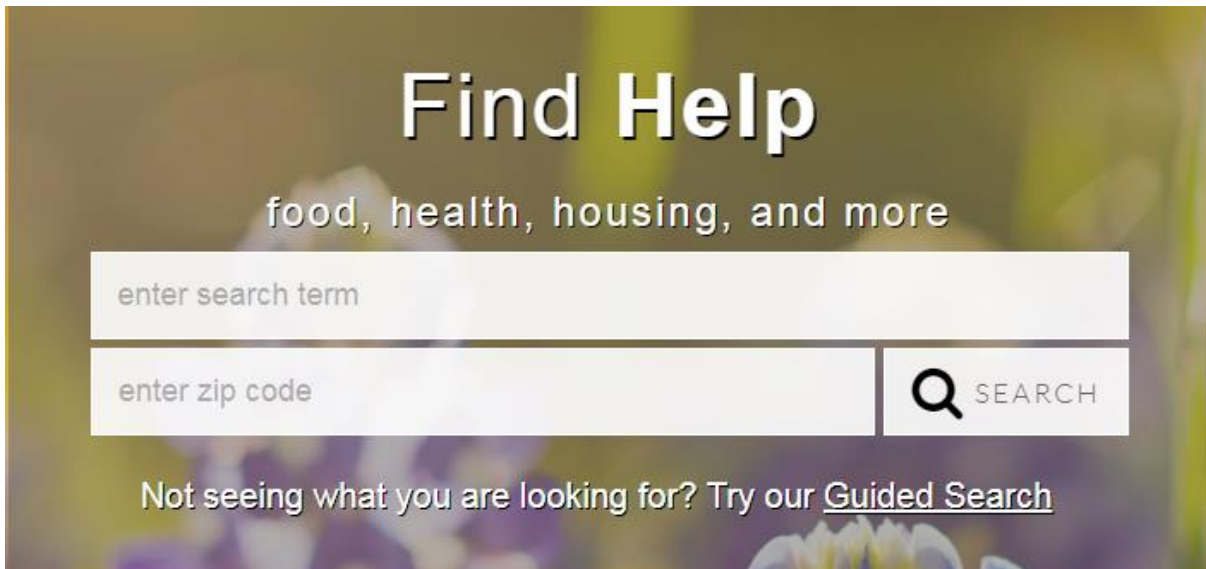
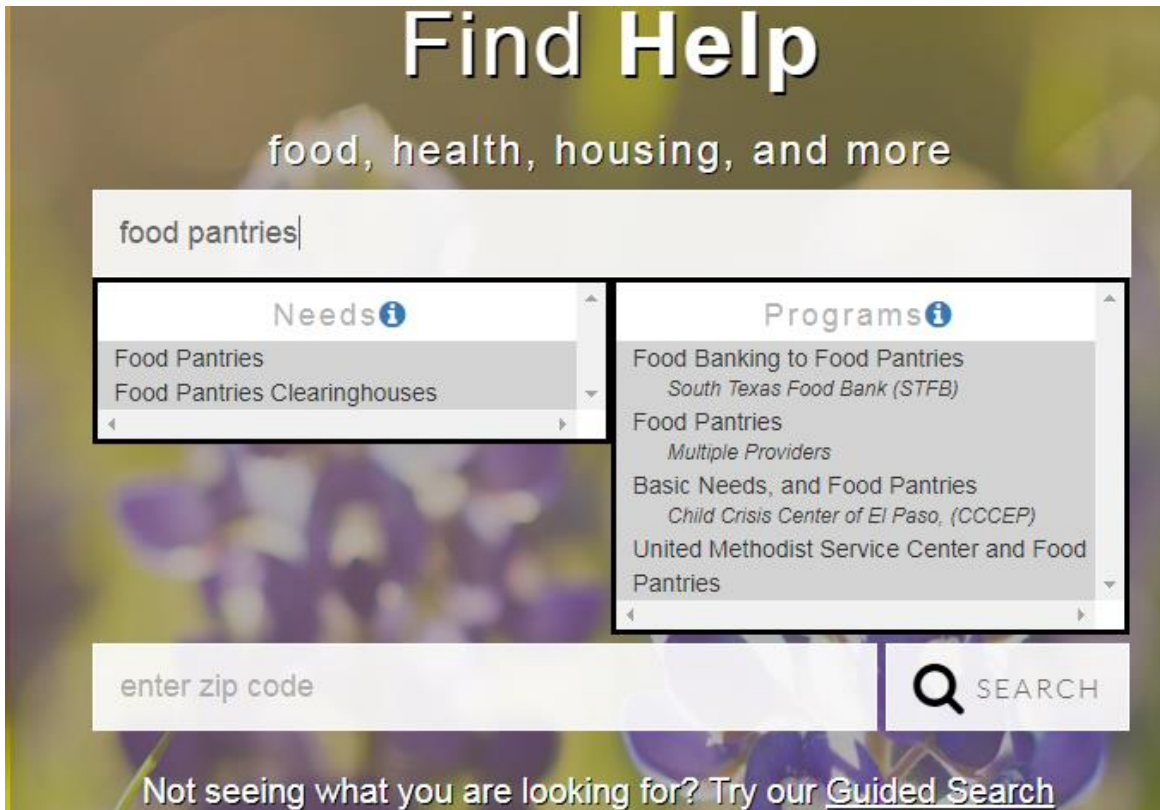


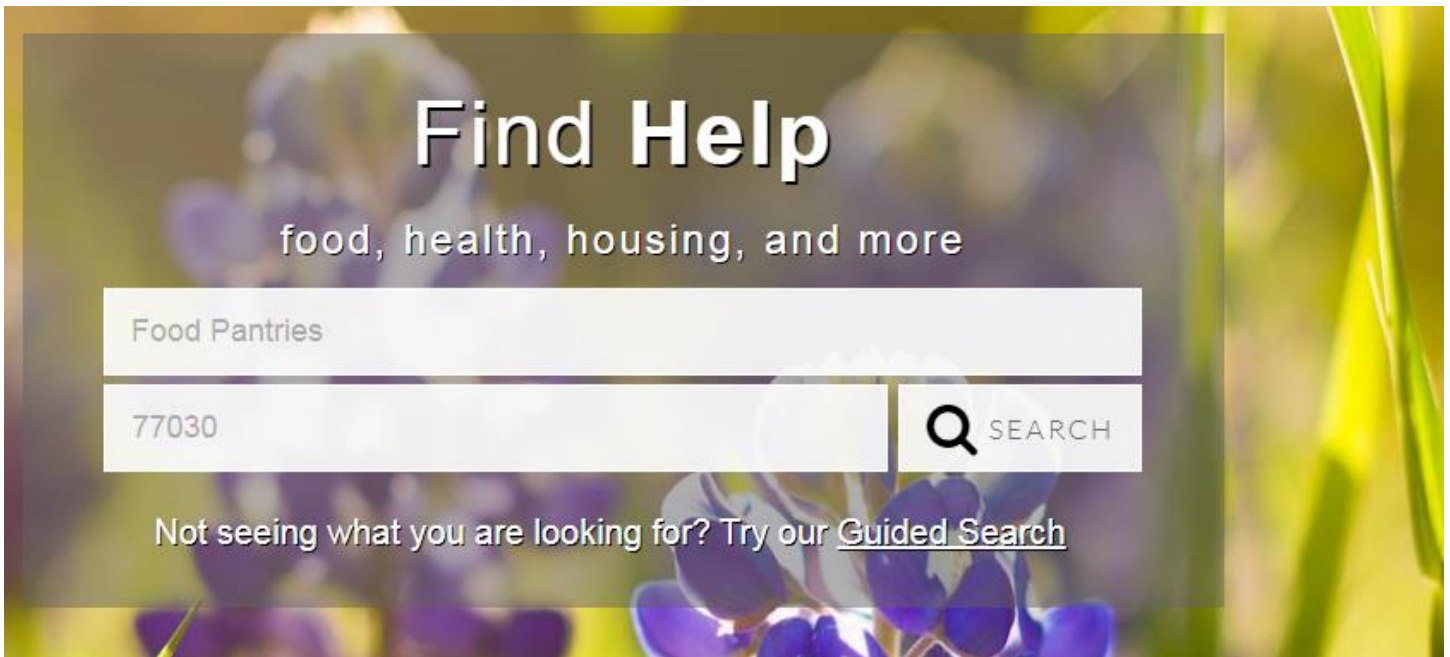
1. Navigate to the home screen:



Description
Provides referrals to churches in their collaborative that **may have** resources for emergency assistance, for rent (including deposits), mortgage, utilities (including reconnection fees), food and other undesigned needs.
All locations have vouchers to St. Vincent de Paul's thrift stores where clients can receive clothing, furniture and when available, appliances.

Note: Funds are provided by donations from church members. The funds are used for the zip codes that are served by that church. IF there are funds available for the help-seeker's zip code, they will be given another phone number to the church serving their zip code. If no funds are available for their zip code, the caller will be told this. *If there is no answer, the caller can leave a message and their call will be returned in the order it was received. Leaving multiple messages will delay the returned call.*

Rent and Utility deposits, reconnection fees and late fees will be considered on a case by case basis - if funds are available.

Eligibility:

Open to residents in the service area. No services are guaranteed for the zip codes served. Callers must call the agency and verify what resources are available for each zip code.

NOTE: eligibility may differ from parish to parish including how often in a year someone can receive assistance. Caller will need to confirm this.

- Pay close attention to the Service Area to make sure that the person can access the service. The database should pull information for the program that serves the person's zip code; however, it is always best to check.
- It is possible to create a PDF file of the service for easy printing or emailing of service referrals** (see box circled above). A sample of the PDF is included at the end of this document.

The record contains all information that the agency has provided 2-1-1 regarding how to access the services.

It is also possible to **search an agency's additional services** listed in 211. Simply scroll to the bottom of the agency's page, click the program name (listed in blue) that you want more information on.

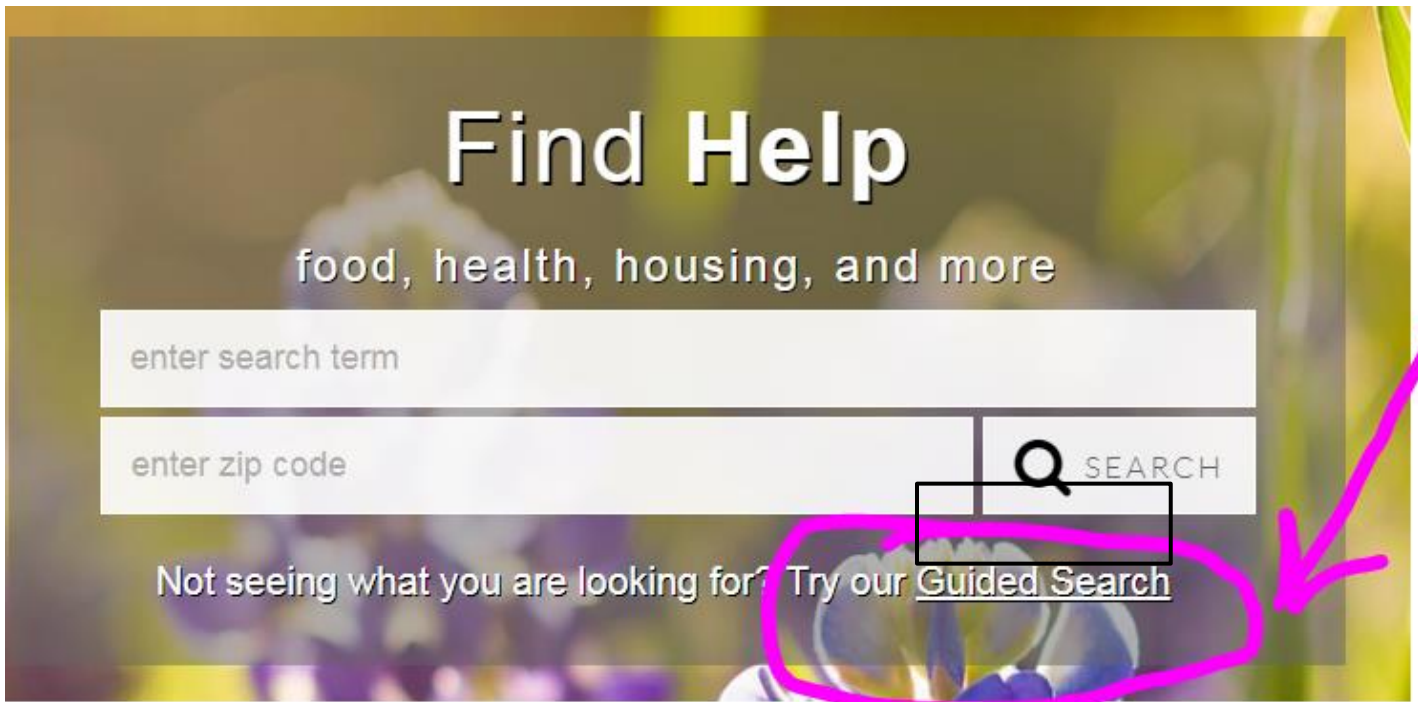

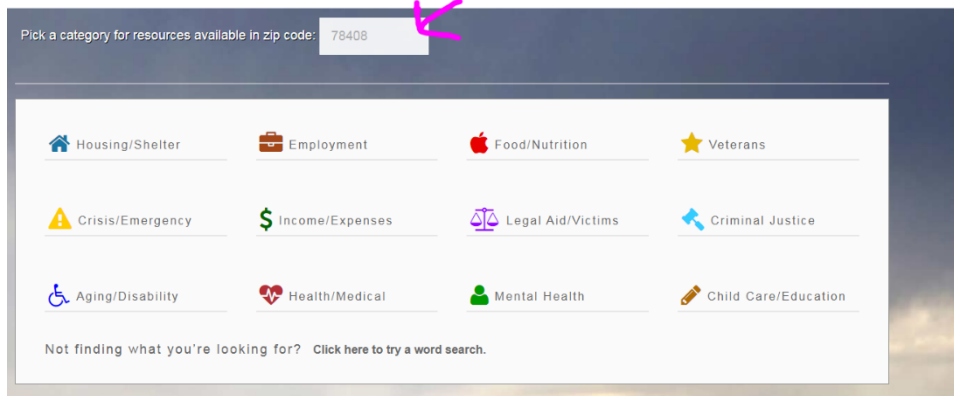

4. The **Guided Search** feature is another way to locate services when the search term is not known or isn't producing results for the client.



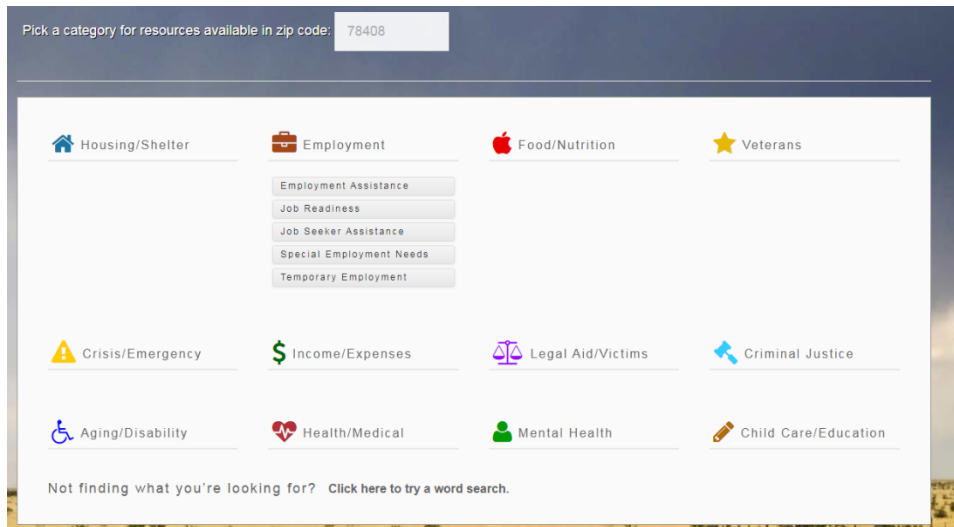
When you click on “Guided Search”, the screen will look like this:



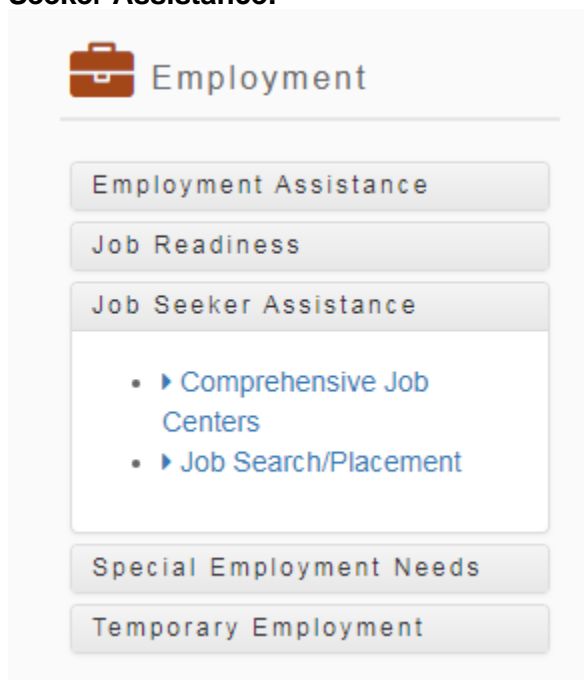
The **zip code still needs to be entered** to produce results accurate for the client's situation.

In this example, **Employment** is selected for the initial search:



Select a category that is most applicable to the client's need. In this case, the search selected is **Job Seeker Assistance**:



Selecting **Comprehensive Job Centers** provides 19 results (when searching on zip code 77030). It is now possible to select the service that may be most appropriate to the client and review the program detail page. There may be several and this provides the client the ability to choose the program that fits their particular needs.



Notice that in the search bar **the term Comprehensive Job Centers is changed to Comprehensive Job Assistance Centers**. This change is because the search term in the database is actually Comprehensive Job Assistance Centers and it has Comprehensive Job Centers as one of its keywords tags.
